Dear Parents and Guardians

I hope you have enjoyed your half term break and your child is looking forward to returning to school on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

If your child returns to school, this is confirmation that they, or any members of the household, are free of any symptoms related to the Covid-19 virus.

The main symptoms of the virus include

- A fever of 37.8 or higher – feeling hot to touch on the chest or back
- A new continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you have noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If any families have been abroad over the half term break, please check the travel advice on the Gov.uk website <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-countries-and-territories-exempt-from-advice-against-all-but-essential-international-travel> for the most up to date advice relating to travel corridors. If the country is NOT on the exempt list, you will have to quarantine for 14 days. This website is regularly updated and we would urge you to check this before you plan to return.

As well as travelling abroad, local restrictions have been put in place across the country. When we return, the School Risk Assessment will still be in place and this document is regularly reviewed.
