Welcome to the Spring Term! I trust you have all had a lovely Christmas break and the children are ready to get back into nursery life. I hope you managed to read the Autumn Term Summary on Tapestry, as a round-up of your child's learning and development.

Our topic this half term is entitled 'Transport'. Each week we will focus on a different mode of transport. We started with 'The Wheels on the Bus'. The role play area turned into a bus stop and the children made a bus by moving the classroom chairs!

For our adult led activity the children were encouraged to count how many people were on the bus. For some children, we focused on counting in order, some were asked to roll a dice and put the corresponding amount of people on board, some added more people and some took them away. The activity was differentiated depending on their individual ability. The observations will be added to Tapestry throughout the week.

On Tuesday 22nd January, the parents of children due to start Reception in September are invited to attend Star Assembly in Bronte Hall. You are welcome to join the Pre-Prep Department and visit the Reception class afterwards for refreshments.
